

Entry Information - 22nd Annual Fayette Art Show - Saturday, Aug. 5, 2023

13TH ANNUAL FAYETTE FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS



As in past years, generous monetary prizes and ribbons will be awarded to winning entries in five entry fields. The show is sponsored by the Fayette Area Heritage Association (FAHA) in concert with other organizations and area businesses. The art show is part of the annual Festival of the Arts which features an all-day program of big and small bands, vocalists, light opera, bluegrass, drama, and historic enactments — presented in and around the historic Howard County Courthouse.

Adult professional and amateur art work will be displayed in the **Ashby-Hodge Gallery of American Art** housed on the main floor of CMU's Classic Hall located a block north of the square. Student works will be displayed **inside the courthouse**.

All festival events take place Saturday, August 5 beginning at 9 a.m. The art exhibits will be open for public viewing that day from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The times and places for artists to bring their work are specified on the reverse side of this entry. There will be a 25 percent commission on any art sold as a result of this showing.

ELIGIBILITY CLASSIFICATIONS

I. Adult Professional

- A. Anyone who sells for profit or publication
- B. Anyone who teaches art classes for reimbursement
- C. Anyone having done graduate work in art.

II. Adult Amateur

Anyone having limited training, workshops, community art classes, or vocational interest in art. The Admissions Committee will determine eligibility.

III. Elementary Students

IV. Middle School Students

V. High School Students

A student's eligibility category is determined by his/her status during the 2022-2023 school year.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

To register, present your artwork in accord with dates and times specified on the entry form.

ENTRY FIELDS

- (1.) Painting in Oil or Acrylic
- (2.) Painting in Water Color or Pastel
- (3.) Drawing in Pencil, Pen & Ink, or Charcoal
- (4.) Photography
- (5.) Sculpture
- (6.) Varied Media - Computer Art, Mixed Media, Fiber Art but no sewing, quilting or needlework.

ENTRY RULES

1. A fee of \$10 per entry is payable on registration for Professional & Amateur entries. Checks are payable to Fayette Area Heritage Association Festival. **There is no charge for student entries.**

2. A total of up to four entries may be submitted by any artist.

3. Entries will be checked by members of the Admissions Committee for size, originality, proper hanging equipment, and proper eligibility classification and entry field. All works must be appropriate for family viewing.

4. Entries should be recent works not previously shown at this event. They should be original; copies of professional photographs and artwork of others are not acceptable.

5. No wet or unframed work will be accepted. Entries must be ready to hang with suitable wire securely fastened from side to side on the back of the frame. We cannot accept saw-tooth or loop hangers on paintings, drawings or photos. Student entries do not need to be framed but should be matted.

6. Because space is limited on hanging pieces, framed entries may not be more than 40-inches in height or 40-inches in width, including the frame. Sculptural works may not exceed those dimensions and 30-inches in depth.

7. All reasonable care will be given to objects in custody of the Admissions Committee. Works are, however, submitted at the artist's risk. FAHA or the Festival of the Arts Committee cannot assume responsibility for damage or deterioration incurred before, during or after the exhibition. Submission of any entry in the exhibit constitutes an agreement on the part of the exhibitor to these conditions.

8. A telephone contact number must be given on the registration form. **A name, address and phone number also must be attached to the back or underside of each piece entered.**

DISMANTLING PROCEDURE

The exhibits will be dismantled beginning at 3:30 p.m., Saturday, August 5. **Entries may not be removed before that time.** Claim checks are to be presented when removing works and all work must be removed by 5 pm on that day unless special arrangements are made.

JUDGING AND PRIZES

1. Adult entries in Professional and Amateur Photography will be judged by Jennifer Kettle of St. Louis, former Fayette newspaper reporter/photographer. All other adult entries will be judged by Emily Benner of St. Louis, art instructor at Lafayette High School in St. Louis County. Judges for the student entries will be announced later. All judging will take place before the Art Show opens.

2. First, second and third place ribbons will be awarded for each of the five entry fields in the Adult Professional, Adult Amateur, Elementary, Middle School, and High School classifications. First place winners in each Professional field will receive \$100. First place winners in each Amateur field will receive \$50, and each first-place winner in each category of the three student classifications will receive \$20.

3. The "Best of Show Award" will receive a \$50 prize and will be chosen by the judges from among the Blue Ribbon Winners.

4. The Dale Graham Award for best black and photo will be \$100.

5. A People's Choice Award in the adult exhibit will be chosen by ballot of exhibit viewers at that show and will receive a ribbon and an award of \$75. A Student People's Choice Award will be chosen by viewers at that show and will receive a ribbon and an award of \$50. **Voting on the People's Choice Awards will be limited to only those works which have been awarded a ribbon.**

Student entries not previously picked-up from the schools will be received in the County Clerk's office in the courthouse on Monday and Tuesday, July 31 and August 1, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. There is **NO FEE** for these entries. Student entries must have matted artwork labeled on the back with name, school and grade in school during the 2022-23 school year.

Adult Professional and Amateur entries will be received at the Ashby-Hodge Gallery of American Art (located in Classic Hall on the CMU campus) on Monday and Tuesday, July 31 and August 1, between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. There is an entry fee of \$10 for each work submitted. Make checks payable to Fayette Area Heritage Association Festival.

There is a limit of four (4) works per artist.

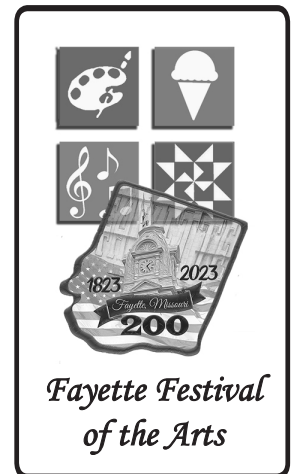
